Seth Goldberg, Head Coach



Seth began his coaching career at **Bishop O'Connell High School** in Northern Virginia under Joe Wootten, son of the Hall of Fame coach, Morgan Wootten. In four seasons at O'Connell, Seth helped the team finish in the *USA Today's* National Top-20 twice. O'Connell also won 2 Virginia State Tournament Championships, 2 Alhambra Catholic Invitational Tournament Championships, and a WCAC tournament championship in that time. While at O'Connell, Seth coached players who went on to receive scholarships from the University of North Carolina, University of Maryland, Loyola College, St. Joseph's University, University of Louisville, and Lehigh.

Seth then went on to coach under 2004 McDonalds All-American Coach, Bob Flynn, at **Cardinal Gibbons High School**. He spent one year at Gibbons, where he was able to help many of the players develop, including one player who received a scholarship to play basketball at the University of Southern Mississippi State.

The following season, Seth went with Coach Flynn to **McDaniel College** where they were able to revitalize a struggling program, winning 9 games for the first time in 10 years, and bringing excitement back to the Men's Basketball Program at McDaniel College. At McDaniel, like he did at O'Connell and Gibbons, Seth showed why he is considered a master teacher of the fundamentals.

As the Head Coach at St. Paul's he has seen a once struggling program improve over each of the last two years. Last Season he lead the Crusaders to the playoffs for the 1st time in five years. They are hoping to build on their success as they return ten of there twelve players from last year's team.

For the last eight summers, Seth has worked as a coach and commissioner at **Coach Wootten's Basketball Camp**. Coach Wootten's Camp is widely recognized as the best teaching overnight basketball camp in the country. It is no wonder where Coach Goldberg learned his craft; and now he brings his knowledge to St. Paul's and SGBC.
